He ultimately struck out on his own, as a free-lance communications consultant for many of Washington's "V.I.P. clients."

After spending most of his professional life in Washington, Joe returned to New England where he became reunited with Dorna Allen, whom he knew from his early childhood days.

Their late-in-life reunion would become the most important and loving relationship of Joe's life.

The couple settled in Sandwich, where they spent nearly a decade together before Dorna's passing, several years ago, following a lengthy battle with cancer.

Joe described their time together as, "both romantic and tragic at the same time."
