
On my Dad's behalf, I toured many care facilities before my sister found Decatur House. The facilities I toured were way too large to navigate physically, and lacked intimacy and charm.



Simply stated, Decatur House is without compare – really an idyllic setting that has a feeling of warmth and safety while also exquisitely beautiful inside and out.


